Read:

+ Luke 5:1-11

Remember:

+ *I was created for closeness with Christ.*

Discuss:

- + Have you ever felt far from God?
- + When do you feel closest to Jesus?

Pray:

- + Parents, pray that each member of your family would become aware of their need for Jesus.

Car-ride Question

What was the most important or helpful truth you learned about being connected to Jesus today?

Family Discussion

Read:

+ John 21:15-19

Remember:

+ *Jesus knows our weakness and he still wants us.*

Discuss:

- + How does this passage shape the way you see your mistakes and weaknesses?
- + How does this passage shape the way you see God's grace?

Pray:

- + Kids, pray that your whole family would understand the grace of God more deeply



A New Way of Working

June 15 & 18

Car-ride Question

What was the most important or helpful truth you learned about being connected to Jesus today?

Family Discussion

Read:

+ 1 Peter 1:17-21

Remember:

+ *If I believe in Jesus, his blood brings me back to God.*

Discuss:

- + What things in life do you think are "empty" or meaningless?
- + How difficult is it for you to see God as your "Father"?

Pray:

- + Parents, pray that your family would begin to see themselves more clearly as God's children
