WHAT TO PREPARE: Print a copy of the "Question & Answers" page and the "Answer Cards" pages. Cut the answer cards and throw away the blank ones.

WHAT YOU DO:

- If everyone playing is a good reader, let everyone play individually. If you need to, partner those who struggle with a someone who is a better reader.
- Everyone should gather around a table with all of the "Answer Cards" face up on the table.
- Read a question from the "Questions & Answers" page.
- Once you read the question, players race to be the first to grab the correct answer card.
- Continue to play until all questions have been answered and cards have been won. Count up to see who has the most cards and declare the winner!
- Play again if you have time.

WHAT YOU SAY:

Don't you love how God heard Elijah's cry for a friend and answered it! God knew that Elisha and Elijah would be perfect friends to each other. As the years went by, their friendship and love for each other grew. Elisha refused to leave Elijah multiple times! That's what friends do. They refuse to leave you when you're sad, confused, or hurting. Instead they stay by you and encourage you with their words and actions.
